Watercourse and Wetland Alteration and Buffer Zone Policy

This was originally drafted in October 2009. In November 2021 there was a combined Environmental Land Management Section Policy document which incorporated this Watercourse and Wetland Alteration and Buffer Zone Policy into it. The Watercourse and Wetland Alteration and Buffer Zone Policy would have been reviewed in 2021 as part of this larger policy initiative and was signed off at the Deputy Minister level in November 2021.
