— PETROLEUM PRICING —

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, June 4, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, June 4, 2021:

- The price of both gasoline and furnace oil will increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of diesel will increase by 3.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.6 cpl for Superior Propane; by 0.2 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 0.1 cpl for Island Petroleum; and there is no change in price for both Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 130.4 to 131.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 129.6 to 130.8 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 97.2 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 82.1 to 82.9 cpl.
