PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, June 11, 2021 – The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, June 11, 2021:

- The price of gasoline, furnace oil, and diesel will each increase by 1.0 cent per litre (cpl);

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 131.6 to 132.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 130.8 to 131.9 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 98.3 cpl.
