## PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, June 18, 2021 – The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, June 18, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will decrease by 1.2 cents per litre (cpl);
- There is no change to the price of diesel or furnace oil; and
- Propane prices will increase by 2.2 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 2.1 cpl for Superior Propane; by 2.3 cpl for Island Petroleum; and by 2.0 cpl for both Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 130.2 to 131.3 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 130.8 to 131.9 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 98.3 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 84.3 to 84.9 cpl.
