PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, June 25, 2021 – The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, June 25, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 3.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 1.9 cpl; and
- The price of diesel will increase by 2.0 cpl.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 133.6 to 134.8 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 133.1 to 134.2 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 100.3 cpl.
