PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, July 2, 2021 – The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, July 2, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 1.1 cpl;
- The price of diesel will increase by 1.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 2.0 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 2.1 cpl for Superior Propane; by 1.8 cpl for Island Petroleum; and by 2.4 cpl for both Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 135.9 to 137.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 134.2 to 135.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 101.4 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 86.3 to 87.3 cpl.
