PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, July 30, 2021 – The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, July 30, 2021:

- The price of gasoline, furnace oil, and diesel will each increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- Propane prices will increase by 1.3 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 1.6 cpl for Superior Propane and Island Petroleum; and by 0.7 cpl for Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 138.9 to 140.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 136.0 to 137.2 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 103.6 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 91.2 to 91.5 cpl.
