The following is distributed by Island Information Services at the request of the Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission:

PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 13, 2021 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 13, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will decrease by 1.3 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will decrease by 2.3 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.5 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 0.3 cpl for Island Petroleum, Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum; and there is no change for Superior Propane.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 137.4 to 138.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 133.4 to 134.6 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 101.2 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 91.4 to 92.0 cpl.
