## PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 20, 2021 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 20, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will decrease by 3.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will decrease by 1.3 cpl.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 134.0 to 135.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 131.9 to 133.1 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 99.9 cpl.
