PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 27, 2021 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 27, 2021:

- There is no change to the price of gasoline, furnace oil, or diesel; and
- Propane prices will increase by 1.2 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 0.8 cpl for Island Petroleum; by 1.1 cpl for Superior Propane; and by 1.5 cpl for both Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 134.0 to 135.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 131.9 to 133.1 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 99.9 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 92.5 to 93.2 cpl.
