PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, September 10, 2021 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, September 10, 2021:

- The price of gasoline, furnace oil, and diesel will each increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.3 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 0.8 cpl for Superior Propane; and by 0.5 cpl for Island Petroleum, Kenmac Energy, and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 138.8 to 140.0 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 138.0 to 139.2 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 105.4 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 93.0 to 93.5 cpl.
