PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 6, 2022 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 6, 2022:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 8.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of furnace oil and diesel will each decrease by 7.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 0.9 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 1.0 cpl for Superior Propane, by 4.0 cpl for Island Petroleum, and there is no change for both Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 194.2 to 195.4 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 253.5 to 254.6 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 207.2 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 103.4 to 104.0 cpl.
