PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 20, 2022 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 20, 2022:

- The price of gasoline will decrease by 4.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will decrease by 25.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 0.8 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 1.2 cpl for Superior Propane, by 5.0 cpl for Island Petroleum, and by 1.4 cpl for both Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 205.6 to 206.8 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 213.7 to 214.8 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 165.2 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 98.7 to 102.9 cpl.
