## PETROLEUM PRICING

**Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, July 1, 2022** – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, July 1, 2022:

- There is no change to the price of gasoline;
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will decrease by 8.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.4 cpl for Superior Propane, will decrease by 0.8 cpl for Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum, and there is no change for both Irving and Island Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 210.7 to 211.8 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 227.8 to 229.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 175.7 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 97.7 to 100.9 cpl.

The Commission's next scheduled pricing adjustment is July 8, 2022.
