PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, December 1, 2023 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, December 1, 2023:

- The price of gasoline will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will not change;
- The price of diesel will not change; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 0.2 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 0.3 cpl for Superior Propane, by 0.4 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 0.4 cpl for Noonan Petroleum, the price for Island Petroleum will not change.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 162.6 to 163.8 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 207.5 to 208.6 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 148.1 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 80.8 to 81.8 cpl.
