PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, February 16, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, February 16, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 2.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 1.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will not change; and

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 163.4 to 164.6 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 172.8 to 174.0 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 202.9 to 204.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 144.9 cpl.
