PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 19, 2024– The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, April 19, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 4.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 3.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 3.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 4.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.4 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 0.4 cpl for Superior Propane, the price will not change for Island Petroleum, Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 177.6 to 178.7 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 190.4 to 191.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 186.2 to 187.3 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 134.4 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 86.4 to 88.5 cpl.
