PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 26, 2024– The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, April 26, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 5.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 4.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 4.0 cpl; and
- The price of diesel will not change;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 183.3 to 184.5 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 195.0 to 196.2 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 186.2 to 187.3 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 130.2 cpl.
