PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, June 28, 2024—The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, June 28, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 2.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 2.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will not change; and
- Propane prices will increase by 1.4 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 0.7 cpl for Superior Propane, by 2.4 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc., by 2.4 cpl for Noonan Petroleum and the price will decrease by 1.3 cpl for Island Petroleum,

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 175.3 to 176.4 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 186.8 to 187.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 182.4 to 183.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 128.1 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 79.0 to 83.5 cpl.
