PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, July 26, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, July 26, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 0.1 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 0.2 cpl for Superior Propane, by 1.4 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc., by 1.4 cpl for Noonan Petroleum. and the price will increase by 3.0 cpl for Island Petroleum,

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 175.8 to 177.0 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 186.8 to 187.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 181.2 to 182.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 126.0 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 82.0 to 83.7 cpl.
