PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 2, 2024— The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 2, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will not change; and
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 175.8 to 177.0 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 186.8 to 187.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 180.1 to 181.2 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 126.0 cpl.
