PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, September 13, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, September 13, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 3.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 3.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 2.0 cpl; and
- The price of diesel will not change;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 155.7 to 156.9 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 167.2 to 168.4 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 165.1 to 166.3 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 111.3 cpl.
