PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, October 18, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, October 18, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 2.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will increase by 2.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 3.2 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 0.6 cpl for Superior Propane, by 2.0 cpl for Island Petroleum, by 4.3 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 4.3 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 163.8 to 164.9 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 171.8 to 173.0 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 177.2 to 178.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 120.8 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 79.5 to 81.5 cpl.
