PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, November 22, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, November 22, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 0.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 1.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 3.5 cpl; and
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.0 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 163.2 to 164.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 173.5 to 174.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 180.7 to 181.8 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 122.3 cpl.
