PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, November 29, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, November 29, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will not change;
- The price of diesel will not change; and
- Propane prices will increase by 2.4 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 2.1 cpl for Superior Propane, by 2.2 cpl for Island Petroleum, by 1.5 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 1.5 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 160.3 to 161.5 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 170.7 to 171.8 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 180.7 to 181.8 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 122.3 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 85.2 to 86.4 cpl.
