PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, December 20, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, December 20, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 1.7 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 5.5 cpl; and
- The price of diesel will increase by 3.5 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 163.2 to 164.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 173.8 to 174.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 185.8 to 187.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 126.5 cpl.
