## NOTICE

### PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, December 27, 2024 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, December 27, 2024:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will not change;
- The price of diesel will not change; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 1.0 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing, by 0.8 cpl for Superior Propane, by 0.5 cpl for Avenir Energy, the price will not change for Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 163.2 to 164.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 173.8 to 174.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 185.8 to 187.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 126.5 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 85.7 to 86.4 cpl.
