## NOTICE

### PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 10, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 10, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 4.8 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 2.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 4.8 cpl;
- The price of diesel will increase by 4.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.7 cpl for Irving Energy, by 1.0 cpl for Superior Propane, by 0.5 cpl for Avenir Energy, by 2.0 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 2.0 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 169.9 to 171.0 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 177.8 to 178.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 193.3 to 194.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 135.2 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 86.2 to 88.4 cpl.
