PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 17, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 17, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will not change; and
- The price of diesel will not change;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 175.0 to 176.2 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 183.0 to 184.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 203.7 to 204.8 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 142.6 cpl.
