PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 31, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 31, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 1.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 1.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 2.5 cpl; and
- The price of diesel will decrease by 2.5 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 173.3 to 174.5 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 183.0 to 184.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 200.8 to 201.9 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 145.1 cpl.
