PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, February 21, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, February 21, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will not change;
- The price of diesel will not change; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.7 cpl for Irving Energy, by 1.1 cpl for Superior Propane, by 0.5 cpl for Avenir Energy, by 1.6 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 1.6 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 170.4 to 171.6 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 180.7 to 181.8 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 200.8 to 201.9 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 142.5 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 97.6 to 99.0 cpl.
