PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, March 14, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, March 14, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 7.5 cents per litre (cpl); and
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.5 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 161.8 to 163.0 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 173.2 to 174.3 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 189.3 to 190.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 123.1 cpl.
