PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 11, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, April 11, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 2.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 4.0 cpl; and
- The price of diesel will decrease by 2.5 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 145.6 to 146.7 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 155.3 to 156.4 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 152.7 to 153.9 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 115.2 cpl.
