PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 18, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, April 18, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 2.5 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 2.5 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 2.6 cpl for Irving Energy, by 2.7 cpl for Superior Propane, by 1.5 cpl for Avenir Energy, by 4.5 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 4.5 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 142.7 to 143.9 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 152.4 to 153.5 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 149.8 to 151.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 112.6 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 91.3 to 92.4 cpl.
