PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 2, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 2, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 7.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 2.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 4.2 cpl for Irving Energy, by 3.7 cpl for Superior Propane, by 2.6 cpl for Avenir Energy, and the price for Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum will not change.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 146.2 to 147.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 153.5 to 154.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 149.8 to 151.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 108.9 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 88.0 to 91.4 cpl.
