PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 9, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 9, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 3.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 3.5 cpl; and

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 146.2 to 147.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 154.7 to 155.8 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 145.8 to 147.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 105.7 cpl.
