PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, June 27, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, June 27, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 6.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 6.5 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 6.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 5.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.6 cpl for Irving Energy, by 1.1 cpl for Superior Propane, by 1.7 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 1.7 cpl for Noonan Petroleum. The price for Avenir Energy will not change.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 147.3 to 148.5 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 155.8 to 157.0 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 159.6 to 160.8 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 114.1 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 82.8 to 85.8 cpl.

The Commission notes that markets continue to experience volatility in response to various global factors. As a result, petroleum product prices have decreased this past week, which is reflected in this week's regularly scheduled price adjustment. The Commission continues to closely monitor market conditions and will appropriately respond to fluctuations, if required.
