PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, July 18, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, July 18, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 1.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will not change; and
- The price of furnace oil will not change;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 149.6 to 150.8 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 158.1 to 159.3 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 164.2 to 165.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 121.0 cpl.
