PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, July 25, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, July 25, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 1.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 1.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 2.5 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 1.1 cpl for Irving Energy, by 1.7 cpl for Superior Propane, by 1.5 cpl for Avenir Energy, the price will not change for Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 147.9 to 149.0 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 157.0 to 158.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 164.2 to 165.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 123.6 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 81.7 to 83.8 cpl.
