PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 8, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 8, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will no change;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 5.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 6.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 0.9 cpl for Irving Energy, and by 0.6 cpl for Superior Propane, the price will not change for Avenir Energy, Kenmac Energy Inc. and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 150.2 to 151.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 160.4 to 161.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 157.3 to 158.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 115.2 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 80.8 to 83.8 cpl.
