PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 15, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 15, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 1.5 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 2.0 cpl; and
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 1.0 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 149.0 to 150.2 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 158.7 to 159.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 155.0 to 156.2 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 114.1 cpl.
