PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 29, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, August 29, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of diesel will increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 1.5 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 150.2 to 151.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 159.9 to 161.0 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 157.3 to 158.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 117.3 cpl.
