## PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, September 5, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, September 5, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 3.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 4.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will not change; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.1 cpl for Irving Energy, by 0.3 cpl for Superior Propane, by 1.2 cpl
  for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 1.2 cpl for Noonan Petroleum. The price for Avenir Energy will not
  change.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 153.6 to 154.8 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 164.5 to 165.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 157.3 to 158.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 117.3 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 80.9 to 84.0 cpl.
