PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, September 26, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, September 26, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 4.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 5.5 cpl;
- The price of diesel will not change; and
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 1.0 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 150.2 to 151.3 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 161.6 to 162.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 158.5 to 159.6 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 119.4 cpl.
