PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, October 3, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, October 3, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 1.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 1.5 cpl;
- The price of diesel will increase by 3.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 2.5 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.9 cpl for Irving Energy, by 1.0 cpl for Superior Propane, by 1.0 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 1.0 cpl for Noonan Petroleum. The price for Avenir Energy will not change.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 148.5 to 149.6 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 159.9 to 161.0 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 162.5 to 163.6 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 122.0 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 82.7 to 85.5 cpl.
