PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, October 17, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, October 17, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 3.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 0.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 1.5 cpl; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.1 cpl for Irving Energy, by 1.0 cpl for Avenir Energy, the price will decrease, by 0.8 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 0.8 cpl for Noonan Petroleum. The price for Superior Propane will not change.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 143.9 to 145.0 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 154.1 to 155.3 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 160.8 to 161.9 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 118.9 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 82.8 to 84.7 cpl.
