PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, December 19, 2025 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, December 19, 2025:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 7.5 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 2.5 cpl; and
- The price of furnace oil will not change;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 137.0 to 138.1 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 143.9 to 145.0 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 168.2 to 169.4 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 119.9 cpl.
