PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 9, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 9, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 2.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will not change;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 2.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 1.7 cpl for Irving Energy, by 1.7 cpl for Superior Propane, by 1.0 cpl for Avenir Energy, by 0.8 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and by 0.8 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 139.3 to 140.4 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 146.2 to 147.3 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 165.9 to 167.1 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 121.0 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 86.6 to 90.7 cpl.
