PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 16, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 16, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 3.5 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 4.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will increase by 5.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 3.0 cpl; and

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 143.3 to 144.4 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 150.8 to 151.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 172.3 to 173.4cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 124.1 cpl.
