PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, February 13, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, February 13, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 2.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of diesel will increase by 9.5 cpl; and
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 4.0 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 149.0 to 150.2 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 156.5 to 157.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 202.2 to 203.3 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 129.4 cpl.
